To honor all community Elders, the Cow Creek Tribe is sponsoring the Glide High School Elder Interview Contest. All Glide High School students are eligible to enter! Final entries must be emailed to info-education@cowcreek-nsn.gov by May 2nd and the winner will be announced by May 16th!

Guidelines:

1. Interview an elder (60+ years of age) of your choice and consider the following topics to ask about:
 - a. **Life Background** (Where/when born, what was hometown like, etc.)
 - b. **Childhood & School** (Happiest childhood memory, favorite teacher, activities)
 - c. **Young Adulthood** (First job, military/college/work/other, how met spouse, etc.)
 - d. **Career & Passions** (Favorite job, proud of most in career, etc.)
 - e. **Historical Events** (Major events experienced, how affected, inventions/technology, etc.)
 - f. **Reflections** (Important life lessons, advice for future generations, family, etc.)
 - g. **Fun & Personal** (Favorite song/book/movie, funny stories, unknown fact, etc.)
2. Next, write a 1–2-page essay including the most important information from the interview.
3. At the end of the essay, include a paragraph explaining why this interview was important and what you gained most from the interview.

Rules:

1. Interview an Elder (60+) of your choice and create a 1–2-page written essay
